
D. Defense by Affidavit in Certain Cases

For any offense not listed on the Statewide Violations Bureau Schedule or on this Local Schedule, a court appearance is required, unless the court authorizes a defense by affidavit in accordance with the provisions of R. 7:6-3 or R. 7:12-3. For offenses involving traffic accidents resulting in personal injury, a court appearance is also required.
