**ORDINANCE 25-2658 - AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 299 OF THE CODE OF THE BOROUGH OF BERGENFIELD, ENTITLED "VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC"**

was introduced at a Work Session Meeting of the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Bergenfield on Tuesday, December 2, 2025 and will be further considered for final passage after public hearing at a meeting of the Mayor and Council to be held in the Council Chamber of the Bergenfield Borough Hall on the 3<sup>rd</sup> Floor, at 198 North Washington Avenue in Bergenfield on Tuesday, December 16, 2025 at 8:00 p.m. prevailing time, or as soon thereafter as the matter can be heard.

A clear and concise statement is to amend the parking limit in the Borough Hall parking lot, as set forth in the ordinance.

**Ordinance No. 25-2658**

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 299 OF THE CODE OF THE BOROUGH OF BERGENFIELD, ENTITLED  
"VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC"**

**WHEREAS**, Chapter 299 of the Code of the Borough of Bergenfield sets forth all regulations regarding Vehicles and Traffic within the Borough of Bergenfield; and,

**BE IT ORDAINED**, by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Bergenfield, County of Bergen and State of New Jersey that those portions of the aforesaid set forth below are hereby amended as follows and that those portions of the Ordinance not set forth below shall remain unchanged.

**Chapter 299-9. Parking time limited in Borough parking lots.**

H. The parking lot at Borough Hall (Block 12, Lot 2) shall be used for Borough Hall business only. No parking shall be allowed for a period of more than three (3) hours. Any further use of the Borough Hall parking lot in excess of three (3) hours must be approved by the Borough Administrator.

I. Violations and penalties. Any person convicted of a violation of a provision of this section or any supplement hereto shall be liable to a penalty of \$55 for each day of occurrence.

Severability All provisions of this Ordinance are severable. If for any reason, any provision of this Ordinance is held to be invalid, the validity of the remainder of the Ordinance shall not be affected.

Effective Date. This Ordinance shall become effective upon final approval and publication, pursuant to law, and upon completion of all outstanding cases.
