ORDINANCE 26-2669 - AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 299 OF THE CODE OF THE BOROUGH OF BERGENFIELD, ENTITLED "VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC"

was introduced at a Regular Meeting of the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Bergenfield, in the County of Bergen, New Jersey, held on Tuesday, June 16, 2026 and will be further considered for final passage after public hearing at a meeting of the Mayor and Council to be held in the third floor Council Chambers in the Borough Hall located at 198 North Washington Avenue, Bergenfield, New Jersey on Tuesday, July 21, 2026 at 8:00 p.m. prevailing time, or as soon thereafter as the matter can be heard.

A clear and concise statement of this ordinance is that no operator of a motor vehicle shall park their vehicle in a driveway without consent from the owner and violations and penalties imposed, as set forth in the ordinance.

BOROUGH OF BERGENFIELD

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 299 OF THE CODE OF THE BOROUGH OF BERGENFIELD, ENTITLED "VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC"

WHEREAS, Chapter 299 of the Code of the Borough of Bergenfield sets forth all regulations regarding Vehicles and Traffic within the Borough of Bergenfield; and,

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Bergenfield, County of Bergen and State of New Jersey that those portions of the aforesaid set forth below are hereby amended as follows and that those portions of the Ordinance not set forth below shall remain unchanged.

New Sec. 299-34. Parking Prohibited in Driveways.

- A. No operator of a motor vehicle shall park their vehicle in a driveway without the consent of the owner or lessee of the property.
- B. **Violations and Penalties.** Any person convicted of a violation of a provision of this section or any supplement of this section, shall be liable to a penalty of up to \$250.00 for each day and may be subject to the towing of the vehicle.

Severability All provisions of this Ordinance are severable. If for any reason, any provision of this Ordinance is held to be invalid, the validity of the remainder of the Ordinance shall not be affected.

Effective Date. This Ordinance shall become effective upon final approval and publication, pursuant to law, and upon completion of all outstanding cases.
