



**BOROUGH OF BERGENFIELD
PUBLIC NOTICE**

**ORDINANCE 26-2670 - AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 299 OF THE
CODE OF THE BOROUGH OF BERGENFIELD, ENTITLED "VEHICLES AND
TRAFFIC"**

was introduced at a Regular Meeting of the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Bergenfield, in the County of Bergen, New Jersey, held on Tuesday, July 21, 2026 and will be further considered for final passage after public hearing at a meeting of the Mayor and Council to be held in the third floor Council Chambers in the Borough Hall located at 198 North Washington Avenue, Bergenfield, New Jersey on Tuesday, August 18, 2026 at 8:00 p.m. prevailing time, or as soon thereafter as the matter can be heard.

A clear and concise statement of this ordinance is that upon the occurrence of a snow emergency declared by the Chief, or the ranking officer in the Chief's absence, within one hour after declaration no person shall cause, permit, allow or suffer any vehicle owned or driven by him to become stalled or immobile on any portion of any street in the Borough of Bergenfield. Any person in violation shall be liable for a penalty of \$200 for each day of occurrence, as set forth in the ordinance.
